HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to S.P. 968, L.D. 2130, Bill,
"AN ACT Implementing Certain Recommendations of the Citizens' Commission to Evaluate the Department of Environmental Protection."

Amend the Bill by inserting after section 14 the following:

'Sec. 15. 38 MRSA §412-B is enacted to read:

§412-B. Municipal and industrial waste disposal

The board shall consult with and advise the authorities of municipalities, persons and businesses having, or about to have, systems of drainage, sewerage or industrial wastes, except purely storm water systems located in or on or draining from public ways, as to the best methods of disposing of the drainage, sewage or industrial wastes with reference to the existing and future needs of the municipality, other municipalities, persons or businesses which may be affected thereby. The board may consult with and advise persons or corporations engaged or intending to engage in any manufacturing or other business whose drainage, sewage or industrial wastes may tend to pollute any waters under the jurisdiction of the board, as to the best methods of preventing such pollution, and it may conduct experiments to determine the best methods of the purification or disposal of drainage, sewage and industrial wastes. Municipalities, sewer districts, quasi-municipal corporations, firms, persons, state agencies and other legal entities shall submit to the board, for its advice and approval, the plans and specifications for any proposed new system of drainage, sewage disposal, sewage treatment or industrial waste disposal into any waters of the State, except purely storm water systems located in or on or draining from public ways and any alterations in existing facilities.
