HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to S.P. 969 , L.D. 2136, Bill,
"AN ACT to Make Corrections of Errors and Inconsistencies
in the Laws of Maine."

Amend the Bill by inserting after section 80 the fol-
lowing:

'Sec. 81. 12 MRSA §9322, sub-§2, as enacted by PL
1979, c. 545, §3, is amended to read:

2. Exemptions. This section shall not apply to the
use of portable stoves which are fueled by propane gas,
gasoline or sterno, or to recreational fires kindled when
the ground is covered with snow.

Further amend the Bill by renumbering the sections to
read consecutively.

There is confusion concerning the provisions of Title
12, chapters 215 and 807; Title 25, section 2436-A and Title
38, section 599, concerning open burning. This amendment
makes it clear that a permit is not required for recrea-
tional fires when the ground is covered with snow.
