| 21 22 23 | Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and |
| 24 25 | Whereas, the Legislature is without the necessary funds to continue operations during the 1981-82 fiscal year; and |
| 26 27 28 | Whereas, this legislation provides funds and other needed authority for the proper operation of the Legis- lature; and |
| 29 30 31 32 33 | Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Consti- tution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, |

1 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows: 2 Sec. 1. Appropriation. The following funds are appro-3 priated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of 4 this Act. 5 1981-82 6 LEGISLATURE 7 Uniform State Laws, Commission for All Other 8 \$ 7,000 9 Provides operating funds. 10 Legislature 11 Personal Services 170,000 12 All Other 200,000 13 Provides for additional oper-14 ating expense due to special 15 sessions and pay adjustments granted by the Legislative Coun-16 17 cil. 18 Maine-Canadian Legislative Advisory 19 Office Personal Services 1,700 20 21 Provides funds for pay adjust-22 ments granted by the Legislative 23 Council. 24 Total \$378,700 Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §1062, sub-§2, ¶G, first 2 sentences, as 25 26 enacted by PL 1981, c. 453, §1, are amended to read: 27 Notwithstanding any other provision in this chapter, 28 the State may agree to provide through a collective employees bargaining contract, and for 29 legislative 30 approved by action of the Legislative Council, payment member's mandatory contribution to the Maine 31 for a 32 State Retirement System, as set by section 1095, in lieu of deducting the contribution from a member's com-33 Payments made pursuant to a collective bar-34 pensation. gaining contract, or through Legislative Council ac-35 36 tion, shall be accumulated in the Retirement Allowance 37 Fund.

5 Sec. 4. PL 1981, c. 493, §5, sub-§1, is amended to 6 read:

The Department of Corrections shall prepare legis-8 lation for presentation to the Second First Regular Session 9 of the 110th 111th Legislature on or before January 31, 10 1982, November 30, 1982, to amend, repeal and rearrange 11 statutes as necessary to reflect the powers, responsibili-12 ties and organization of the Department of Corrections.

13 Sec. 5. Retroactivity. Section 2 of this Act shall be 14 retroactive to July 1, 1981.

15 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in 16 the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

17 STATEMENT OF FACT

18 Section 1 provides emergency funding to meet the costs 19 of special sessions, printing and payrolls of the Legis-20 lature.

21 Sections 2 and 5 provide clarification of statutory 22 authority to permit retirement option for legislative 23 employees as authorized by the Legislative Council.

24 Sections 3 and 4 provide extension of proceedings to 25 November 30, 1982 for submission of rocodification of 26 Department of Mental Health and Corrections law.
