17 **AN ACT to Designate the Director of the**
18 **Bureau of Medical Services as a Major Policy-**
19 **influencing Position Within the Department of**
20 **Human Services.**

22 **Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature
23 do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment
24 unless enacted as emergencies; and

25 Whereas, the Maine Administrative Procedure Act permits
26 only those policymakers specified in Title 5, section 711,
27 to conduct rule-making hearings; and

28 Whereas, the current organization of the Department of
29 Human Services has the Bureau of Medical Services adminis-
30 tering the Medicaid Program; and

31 Whereas, the statutes do not permit the present bureau
32 director to conduct public hearings; and

1 this bill is to allow the Director of the Bureau of Medical
2 Services to comply with the provisions of Title 5, section
3 8052, subsection 2, paragraph B. This section requires any
4 person conducting a hearing pursuant to rule-making provi-
5 sions of the Maine Administrative Procedure Act to be listed
6 in section 711.

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
