clause (page 1, line 29 in L.D.) by striking out the
underlined word "or" and inserting in its place the
underlined word 'and'

The purpose of this amendment is to require a
registrar, registering a voter who had been previ-
ously registered in another municipality, to notify
the registrar of that municipality of both the former
street and mailing address of that voter. In some
cases, the mailing address alone would not be very
helpful in identifying the voter in question. This
information is already being collected by registrars.
This amendment merely requires that both the former
street and mailing address be forwarded to the
voter's former municipality.
