18 at Exit 8 of the Maine Turnpike for
19 Southern Maine Vocational-Technical Institute.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
22 follows:

23 23 MRSA §1201, sub-§33, as repealed and replaced
24 by PL 1981, c. 566, is amended to read:

25 33. St. Joseph's College; Southern Maine
26 Vocational-Technical Institute; University of South-
27 ern Maine; Westbrook College. Signs shall be pro-
28 vided by St. Joseph's College and Westbrook College
29 and installed and maintained by the Maine Turnpike
30 Authority at Exit 8 to replace the existing signs
31 which read "Exit for St. Joseph's College, the Uni-
32 versity of Southern Maine, Westbrook College." The
33 replacement signs shall conform with standards estab-

1 lished by the Maine Turnpike Authority and shall read
2 as follows:
