17 AN ACT to Require that
18 Loads of Gravel, Sand, Crushed
19 Stone or Rubbish be Secure to
20 Prevent Spillage.

22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
23 follows:

24 29 MRSA §1752, as amended by PL 1977, c. 32, is
25 further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph
26 to read:

27 No person may operate or cause to be operated
28 upon any public way a vehicle with a load of gravel,
29 sand, crushed stone, rubbish or trash, unless the
30 load is covered or otherwise secured or confined to
31 prevent any portion of the load from falling from or
32 spilling out of the vehicle.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

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This bill requires that vehicles traveling on public ways with loads of gravel, sand, crushed stone or rubbish be covered, confined or secured to prevent any of the load from spilling out of the vehicle.

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
