COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 24, L.D. 29,
Bill, "AN ACT to Create a Student Seat on the Board
of Trustees of the University of Maine."

Amend the bill in section 1 in section 4, subsection 2, by inserting after the first underlined sentence the following: 'Each term shall expire on May 26th of the appropriate year, except that the retiring member shall serve until a successor is appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Legislature.'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in section 4, subsection 2, line 7 (page 2, line 7 in L.D.) by striking out the underlined word and punctuation "terms." and inserting in their place the following: 'terms, except that an individual appointed to fill an unexpired term of 3 years or less is eligible for appointment 2 full terms. Trustees shall retire on reaching the age of 70.'

26 Further amend the bill in section 1 in section 4, 27 subsection 2, by inserting after the 4th underlined sentence the following: 'In order to restore and 28 29 maintain rotation of terms of office of trustees, an incumbent trustee who was appointed for a term of 7 years at a time subsequent to the expiration of the term of his predecessor in office shall be deemed to 30 31 32 33 have commenced his 7-year term upon the date of the expiration of the term of office of his predecessor 34 35 rather than from the date of his apppointment and qualification. 36
