AN ACT to Raise the Rate of the
State-municipal Revenue Sharing Formula.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, a new state-municipal revenue sharing formula is to take effect July 1, 1983, less than 90 days after the Legislature adjourns; and

Whereas, this bill proposes to modify that formula; and

Whereas, unless this bill is enacted as an emergency measure, great inconvenience and confusion will likely result to the Treasurer of State and municipalities alike since the formula will change part way through the fiscal year; and
