17 AN ACT Relating to Furnishing Liquor to  
18 Certain Persons.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 28 MRSA §1058, as amended by PL 1977, c. 292,  
23 §6, is further amended to read:

24 §1058. Furnishing liquor to certain persons prohib-  
25 ited

26 Whoever, other than a licensee or his agent  
27 within the scope of their employment, knowingly pro-  
28 cures or in any way aids or assists in procuring liq-  
29 uor or whoever furnishes, gives or delivers liquor to  
30 a minor who may not legally purchase liquor for him-  
31 self, or allows any minor to consume intoxicating  
32 liquor, or for any intoxicated person, except that  
33 this provision shall not apply to liquor served to a

1 minor in a home in the presence of his parent or  
2 guardian, shall be punished by a fine of ~~not more~~ not  
3 less than \$200 or by imprisonment for not more than  
4 11 months, or by both.

5 STATEMENT OF FACT

6 The purpose of this bill is to expand the pro-  
7 hibition on furnishing liquor to certain persons to  
8 include allowing any minor to consume intoxicating  
9 liquor and to change the fine of \$200 to a minimum  
10 level.

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
