6 7 8	COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " $A$ " to H.P. 46, L.D. 51, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Fuel Adjustment Clause of Natural Gas Utilities."
9 10	Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:
11 12 13	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
14 15	Whereas, certain industrial customers receive natural gas on an interruptible nonfirm basis; and
16 17 18	Whereas, many of these customers have dual fuel capability and might switch to oil now that oil prices are dropping; and
19 20	Whereas, a separate rate schedule for nonfirm gas customers might facilitate market competition; and
21 22 23 24	Whereas, the season from April to October, outside the heating season, is the time when natural gas is generally available to serve nonfirm customers; and
25 26 27 28 29 30	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
31 32 33 34	Further amend the bill in subsection 2 in the last line (page 2, line 14 in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined word and punctuation "basis." the following:

## COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 46, L.D. 51

1 2 3 4	'The rates charged to nonfirm customers shall include a cost of gas as determined by the commission and the total rate charged to nonfirm customers shall be subject to the approval of the commission.'
5 6	Further amend the bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:
7 8 9	'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.'
10	STATEMENT OF FACT
11 12 13 14	The amendment makes it clear that the Public Utilities Commission may establish a separate rate, including cost of gas, to nonfirm customers of natural gas.
15 16 17	The amendment also adds an emergency clause to allow action before April, when nonfirm gas generally becomes available.
