AN ACT to Reduce the Special Limit for
Motor Trucks to 5 Miles Per Hour less than
that set for Passenger Vehicles.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
follows:
29 MRSA §1257 is enacted to read:
§1257. Motor trucks
If a speed limit for any point is established by
this subchapter, or by any other provision of law, or
is set pursuant to section 1251, the speed limit for
motor trucks at that point shall be 5 miles per hour
less than the speed for other motor vehicles, except
that this does not apply to speed limits set for
mobile homes, school buses or motor driven cycles.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide for a reduced speed limit for motor driven trucks that will be 5 miles per hour less than the speed limit set for passenger cars.
