17 AN ACT Relating to Motor Vehicle  
18 Inspection Stickers.  
19

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 29 MRSA §2518, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1979, c.  
23 464, §5, is amended to read:

24 1. Disposition of stickers. Each official  
25 inspection station shall stock a sufficient number of  
26 stickers to meet their demands at all times. These  
27 shall be furnished by the Chief of the State Police  
28 at 25¢ each. The stickers shall be made of such mate-  
29 rial and quality of adhesive as prescribed by the  
30 Chief of the State Police. At the end of the calendar  
31 year, or if the station license is suspended, any  
32 unused or expired stickers shall, within 5 20 working  
33 days, be returned to the Chief of the State Police

1 and the purchase price refunded or exchanged for cur-  
2 rent year stickers, except that refunds or exchanges  
3 shall not be made for an amount less than \$1 other  
4 than full sheets of unused stickers.

5 STATEMENT OF FACT

6 This bill allows an even exchange of outdated  
7 inspection stickers for current year certificates,  
8 increase the minimum refund from \$1 to \$5, and  
9 increase the amount of time which the stations have  
10 to return stickers from 5 to 20 days.
