## STATEMENT OF FACT

6 The purpose of this bill is to repeal those 7 provisions of the current "billboard law" that pro-8 hibit a business from placing directional signs along 9 the same road on which the business is located. This 10 change will permit businesses to provide travelers 11 with up to a 10-mile notice that their particular 12 business lies ahead on that road.

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
