17 AN ACT Relating to Initial Registration
18 Plates.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 29 MRSA §192, 2nd ¶, as amended by PL 1981, c.
23 492, Pt. E, §2, is further amended to read:

24 The registration plates so provided shall be
25 issued only upon application therefor, and upon pay-
26 ment of an annual service fee of \$15, except that for
27 registration plates issued pursuant to the next para-
28 graph, the \$15 service fee shall be a one-time fee.
29 The service fee is to be in addition to the regular
30 motor vehicle registration fee as prescribed by law
31 for the particular vehicle. The amount received for
32 such service fee shall be credited to the General
33 Highway Fund and there shall be allocated annually
34 from the General Highway Fund a sum sufficient to

1 defray the cost of this program.

2 STATEMENT OF FACT

3 The purpose of this bill is to exempt amateur
4 radio station licensees from the requirement of
5 paying an annual \$15 service fee to retain their spe-
6 cial initial license plates. This exemption is
7 granted in recognition of the valuable public service
8 these licensees provide in relaying emergency mes-
9 sages.

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
