12 13 14	'Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis- lature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
15 16 17	Whereas, carriers of logs or pulpwood are currently required to carry cargo insurance at additional costs to their operations; and
18 19 20	Whereas, a significant number of these carriers will have to renew or obtain these policies for the current season if action is not taken promptly; and
21 22 23 24 25 26	Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,'
27 28 29 30 31 32	Further amend the bill in that part designated "§2708." by striking out in the 7th and 8th lines from the end (page 2, lines 8 and 9 in L.D.) the underlined words "unfinished wood products" and inserting in their place the underlined words 'logs or pulpwood'
33 34	Further amend the bill by inserting before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency
