1 Sec. 3. Transition period. The repeal of the Revised Statutes, Title 29, section 1374 shall not 2 take effect until regulations governing the operation 3 4 and use of illuminated advertising devices on motor vehicles have been adopted by the Department of Transportation in accordance with the Maine Adminis-5 6 7 trative Procedure Act, Title 5, chapter 375, and have become effective, or December 31, 1983, whichever 8 9 first occurs.

## 10 STATEMENT OF FACT

11 The purpose of this bill is to permit the use of 12 illuminated advertising devices on motor vehicles. 13 The Commissioner of Transportation is authorized to 14 adopt appropriate regulations governing the operation 15 and use of these devices.

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
