17 AN ACT to Require the Secretary of  
18 State to Give Notification when the  
19 Renewal of Motor Vehicle Registrations  
20 are Due.

22 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
23 follows:

24 29 MRSA §106-B is enacted to read:

25 §106-B. Notification of expiration

26 The Secretary of State or his designee shall  
27 notify any holder of a motor vehicle registration,  
28 which is due to expire, of the date of that expira-  
29 tion. This notification shall be sent no more than  
30 60 days nor less than 30 days before the expiration  
31 date of the holder's registration. In addition to  
32 the fee for registration required under section 242,  
33 the Secretary of State may require payment at the

1 time of registration of an additional fee sufficient  
2 to cover the cost of preparing, processing and mail-  
3 ing notification of expiration under this section.

4 STATEMENT OF FACT

5 This bill would require that the Secretary of  
6 State notify persons when their motor vehicle regis-  
7 trations will expire. The notice will be given  
8 between 30 and 60 days prior to the expiration. The  
9 cost of this notification would be covered by a noti-  
10 fication fee to be paid at the time of registration.

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
