21	STATEMENT OF FACT
22 23 24 25 26 27 28	The purpose of this amendment is to remove the requirement contained in the bill that the text of constitutional resolutions and statewide referenda be printed on posters which would be displayed at each polling place. The text would have to be displayed but the medium in which it would be set out would be optional.
