**AN ACT to Exempt Certain Fire Trucks
From the Motor Vehicle Inspection Laws.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

29 MRSA §2502, sub-§3 is enacted to read:

3. Exception. Notwithstanding subsection 1, any fire truck owned or operated by a municipal or volunteer fire department shall be exempt from motor vehicle inspection requirements imposed by this chapter if there is no motor vehicle inspection station in the town in which the truck is located.
