7 8 9	AN ACT to Clarify the Determination of Axles on Motor Farm Trucks.
0 1	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2 3 1	29 MRSA §439, as amended by PL 1981, c. 492, Pt. A, §5, is further amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:
5 7 3 9	For the purposes of this section, motor truck means a farm motor truck or a farm motor truck haul- ing a trailer, provided that the combined number of axles does not exceed 3, and the truck or truck and trailer is being used to convey agricultural commodi- ties.

1	STATEMENT OF FACT
2 3 4 5 6	The purpose of this bill is to clarify the deter- mination of the number of axles on motor farm trucks. This will prevent violations when the farm motor truck is hauling a trailer and the trailer axle is included in determining the number of axles.
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
