STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to assure that small employers who maintain a record of low losses will have this good experience reflected in their rates. Presently, under the experience modification system, employers with a payroll of \$200,000 or less annually get little or no premium discount, regardless of their experience. This will also create an incentive for employers to provide safe working conditions.

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
