21 22 23	Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts of the Legis- lature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and
24 25 26	Whereas, the People of the State of Maine have, by referendum, approved a measure to index the state income tax to account for inflation; and
27 28	Whereas, that measure contained an effective date of January 1, 1981; and
29 30 31	Whereas, a retroactive date of January 1, 1981 creates a substantial financial dislocation for the State; and
32 33	Whereas, it was not the intent of the measure to cause such dislocation; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,
7 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:
9 Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §5404 is enacted to read:
10 §5404. Adjustment for 1982 tax year
Taxpayers who paid a tax for a tax year beginning in calendar year 1982 shall be entitled to a refund equal to the difference between the amount paid and the amount that would have been due had the adjustments provided in section 5403 been made.
16 Sec. 2. 1982, I.B. 2, §5 is amended to read:
Sec.5. Effective date. This chapter shall take effect for tax years beginning on or after January 1, 1981 1982.
Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
