17 AN ACT Relating to the Regulation of
18 Septage Disposal.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as
21 follows:

22 38 MRSA §1305, sub-§2, as amended by PL 1979, c.
23 541, Pt. A, §277, is further amended to read:

24 2. Ordinances. This chapter shall not be con-
25 strued as limiting the authority of any municipality
26 to enact ordinances for the regulation of solid waste
27 or septage disposal, provided that such ordinances
28 are not less stringent than or inconsistent with this
29 chapter or the regulations adopted thereunder.

1 STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to give municipali-
3 ties the same regulatory powers over disposal of
4 septage as the law currently gives them over disposal
5 of solid waste and commercial hazardous waste facili-
6 ties.

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
