This chapter shall not be con- strued as limiting the authority of any municipality to enact ordinances for the regulation of solid waste or septage disposal, provided that such ordinances are not less stringent than or inconsistent with this chapter or the regulations adopted thereunder.

STATEMENT OF FACT

2 The purpose of this bill is to give municipali-3 ties the same regulatory powers over disposal of 4 septage as the law currently gives them over disposal 5 of solid waste and commercial hazardous waste facili-6 ties.

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
