15 16	Further amend the bill by inserting before the Statement of Fact the following:
17	'FISCAL NOTE
18 19 20 21	This bill will result in costs to the State of approximately \$30,000 for legal fees with a potential for an additional \$1,500,000 if the State is unsuc- cessful in the resulting civil action.'
22	STATEMENT OF FACT
23 24 25	The purpose of this amendment is to place the maximum recovery for a successful suit against the State at \$1,500,000 instead of \$3,000,000.
