18 Acceptance and Expenditure of Campaign  
19 Funds by Candidates.

21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
22 follows:

23 21 MRSA 1395-A is enacted to read:

24 §1395-A. Limitation on acceptance and expenditure of  
25 contributions

26 No person may accept any contribution or make any  
27 expenditure in support of his candidacy prior to 6  
28 months before the date of the election in which that  
29 person intends to be a candidate.

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STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to limit the time period during which candidates can accept contributions and make expenditures promoting their candidacy.

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
