3. Suspension of size limit. The commissioner may, if he deems it necessary, suspend the application of the size limit imposed under this section in any area or areas of the State that will not grow 2-inch clams.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill established a 2 inch minimum size limit on soft shell clams. This limit will conserve clam resources by reducing the number of immature clams harvested. Clams less than 1/2 inch are exempt to allow handling and transporting of seed clams.
