| 27 | STATEMENT OF FACT |
| 28 29 30 31 | Private and Special Law 1975, chapter 138, section 9, is now permissive. The bill establishes a required minimum payment to the Frye Island Municipal Services Corporation. The only service provided by |

the Town of Standish (except for evaluation and taxation) is the summer use of an equipped fire engine and fire protection. Standish has consistently given 21% of its collected island taxes back to the island to assist in supporting the operation of the ferry. It is the desire of the trustees of the Frye Island Municipal Service Corporation to be assured of a firm yearly financial commitment from Standish.
