B. The lights may only be used within the boundaries of the municipality and may only be activated while the constable is conducting official business.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill includes the municipal constable as an authorized agency for the use of blue lights in connection with motor vehicle law enforcement.

The constable is charged with motor vehicle law enforcement under Title 30, chapter 213, subchapter III-A, within the municipal jurisdiction. As such, a positive means of identification must be available to insure compliance with instructions and provide public confidence of bona fide intent.
