17 18 19	AN ACT Relating to Penobscot Nation Trust Land Designation.
20 21	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
22 23	<b>30 MRSA §6205, sub-§2,</b> as enacted by PL 1979, c. 732, §§1, 31, is amended to read:
24 25 26 27	2. <u>Penobscot Indian territory</u> . Subject to sub- sections 3, 4 and 5, the following lands within the State shall be known as the "Penobscot Indian ter- ritory:"
28	A. The Penobscot Indian Reservation; and
29 30 31 32	B. The first 150,000 acres of land acquired by the secretary for the benefit of the Penobscot Nation from the following areas or lands to the extent that those lands are acquired by the

secretary prior to January 1, 1983 1993, are not held in common with any other person or entity and are certified by the secretary by January 1, 1983 1993, as held for the Penobscot Nation:

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5 The lands of Great Northern Nekoosa Corporation 6 located in T.1, R.8, W.B.K.P. (Lowelltown), T.6, R.1, N.B.K.P. (Holeb), T.2, R.10, W.E.L.S. and 7 T.2, 8 R.9, W.E.L.S.; the land of Raymidga Company located 9 in T.1, R.5, W.B.K.P. (Jim Pond), T.4, R.5, 10 B.K.P.W.K.R. Bartlett), т.5, (King and R.6, 11 B.K.P.W.K.R. and T.3, R.5, B.K.P.W.K.R.; the land of 12 the heirs of David Pingree located in T.6, R.8, W.E.L.S.; any portion of Sugar Island in Moosehead 13 14 Lake; the lands of Prentiss and Carlisle Company 15 located in T.9, S.D.; any portion of T.24, the lands of Bertram C. 16 M.D.B.P.P.; Tackeff or Northeastern Blueberry Company, Inc. 17 in T.19, M.D.B.P.P.; any portion of T.2, R.8, N.W.P.; any por-18 19 tion of T.2, R.5, W.B.K.P. (Alder Stream); the lands of Dead River Company in T.3, R.9, N.W.P., T.2, R.9, 20 N.W.P., T.5, R.1, N.B.P.P. and T.5, N.D.B.P.P.; any 21 22 portion of T.3, R.1, N.B.P.P.; any portion of T.3, 23 N.D.; any portion of T.4, N.D.; any portion of T.39, 24 M.D.; any portion of T.40, M.D.; any portion of T.41, 25 M.D.; any portion of T.42, M.D.B.P.P.; and any por-26 tion of Argyle, including the lands of Diamond International Corporation, International Paper Company and 27 28 Lincoln Pulp and Paper Company toeated in Argyte; and any portion of T.6, R.8, N.W.P., located in Williamsburg, including the lands of Dead River Com-29 30 pany and Lincoln Pulp and Paper Company. 31

1	STATEMENT OF FACT
2	This bill extends the time in which the Penobscot
3	Nation could purchase land that could be designated
4	Penobscot Indian territory. It also extends the area
5	that can be so designated when purchased, to include
6	any portion of Argyle and T.6, R.8, N.W.P., located
7	in Williamsburg.

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
