AN ACT to Remove the Sunset Provision on the Regulation of Business Between Motion Picture Exhibitors and Distributors.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
10 MRSA §1905, as amended by PL 1981, c. 18, is repealed.
STATEMENT OF FACT
The purpose of this bill is to remove the sunset provision on the prohibition of the requirement by motion picture distributors that theatre owners in Maine bid on motion pictures before viewing them. Removal of the sunset provision permanently prohib- its this practice by motion picture distributors. Nearly 20 states have enacted similar prohibitions.

1 The repeal of this sunset provision allows this pro-2 tection of Maine citizens to continue.

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
