	AN ACT Limiting all Dimensional Require- ments in Land Use Control Ordinances and Regulations to those Necessary to Protect the Public's Health and Safety.
	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
	30 MRSA §4962-B is enacted to read:
	§4962-B. Limitation on application of dimensional requirements
	Notwithstanding the provisions of any charter, planning or land use control enabling legislation or the "home rule" powers of individual towns, dimen- sional requirements, including, but not limited to, lot size requirements, frontage and setback require-

quirements, shall not be applied to any legally permissible housing alternative in excess of that 1 2 3 which is actually necessary to protect the public's health and safety. In any zoning district which is 4 5 more than 50% developed prior to the effective date 6 of this section, more stringent dimensional require-7 ments, in keeping with, but not exceeding then exist-8 ing development patterns, may be imposed on new hous-9 ing developments and types.

STATEMENT OF FACT

11 This bill prohibits dimensional requirement in 12 land use control ordinances and regulations which are 13 not necessary to protect the public's health and 14 safety.

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
