21 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
22 follows:

23 Sec. 1. 21 MRSA §102-A, sub-§4, as repealed and  
24 replaced by PL 1973, c. 131, §1, is repealed.

25 Sec. 2. 21 MRSA §102-A, sub-§5, as enacted by PL  
26 1973, c. 131, §2, is amended to read:

27 5. Enrollment. An individual may register and  
28 enroll in a political party at the same time and on  
29 the same form.

30 Sec. 3. 21 MRSA §103-A, as reallocated by 1977,  
31 c. 696, §176, is amended to read:

1     §103-A. Overseas registration

2           1. Application. A person qualified to register  
3 as provided in section 241, subsections 1 to 3, who  
4 is outside the United States may register and enroll  
5 in a political party by filing an application  
6 designed by the Secretary of State and provided by  
7 the registrar, containing the following information:

8           A. First name, middle name or initial and last  
9 name, or first name or initial, middle name and  
10 last name;

11          B. Legal address, including street, street  
12 number, apartment number, town, county and zip  
13 code;

14          C. Mailing address;

15          D. Date of birth;

16          E. Last domicile immediately prior to departure  
17 from the United States;

18          F. Voting precinct or election district of such  
19 last domicile within the United States;

20          G. Whether a citizen by birth or naturalization;  
21 if by naturalization, the date, place and court  
22 of naturalization;

23          H. Notification that failure to complete the  
24 entire application may prevent registration;

25          I. Passport or card of identity registration  
26 number;

27          J. Signature;

28          K. Certification that all information is cor-  
29 rect, sworn before a diplomatic or consular offi-  
30 cial of the United States or before the master of  
31 a United States vessel of 1,000 tons or more;

32          L. Date of application; and

33          M. Date of registration; and
