within Baxter State Park, which have the characteristics set out in section 1. The Joint Standing Committee on Energy and Natural Resources shall review this inventory and make recommendations to the State Planning Office as to which areas are recommended for inclusion in the preserve.

Sec. 3. Acquisition of land. The Bureau of Public Lands shall enter into negotiations with the owners of any land recommended for inclusion in the preserve under section 2, and shall report to the First Regular Session of the 113th Legislature on these negotiations. The report shall include any legislation necessary for the acquisition of the recommended areas.

Sec. 4. Management of preserve. Lands included in the Longfellow Wilderness Preserve shall remain forever wild and shall be managed by the Department of Conservation. These lands shall serve as wildlife sanctuaries where no logging or motorized vehicles shall be permitted.

The purpose of this bill is to create the Longfellow Wildlife Preserve which will include unique natural areas of the Longfellow Mountains.
