18 Numbers.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 35 MRSA §2702 is enacted to read:

23 §2702. Emergency telephone numbers

24 Each telephone exchange within the State shall  
25 contain the following telephone numbers assigned for  
26 emergency services:

27 1. Ambulance. The telephone number 1111 for  
28 emergency ambulance services;

29 2. Fire. The telephone number 2222 for emer-  
30 gency fire fighting services; and

3. Police. The telephone number 3333 for emergency police services.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to require that there be uniform emergency services telephone numbers in all telephone exchanges throughout the State. The number for ambulance service would be 1111, the number for fire services would be 2222 and the number for police would be 3333.
