6 STATEMENT OF FACT

 This purpose of this new draft is to clarify the bill to limit funding only in one subprogram of the H.O.M.E. program. According to this proposal, only the program to provide funds to low income persons to purchase single family owner-occupied dwellings will be limited to dwellings with no more than 2 family units.

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
