AN ACT Concerning Registration of Deer in Unorganized Territories.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
<pre>12 MRSA §7458, sub-§4-A, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 723, §18-E, is amended to read:</pre>
4-A. Keeping an unregistered deer. A person is guilty, except as provided in subsection 15, paragraph G, of keeping an unregistered deer if he keeps an unregistered deer at his home, or at any place of storage except a deer registration station, more than 12 hours; except that an unregistered deer may be kept no more than 24 hours in an unorganized ter-
