IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE
AN ACT Relating to the Limitations on Amounts for School Construction Projects or Minor Capital Outlay Projects.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
20-A MRSA §15903, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 1981, c. 693, §§5 and 8, is amended to read:
1. Application. A school construction project or the minor capital costs of a project with an estimated cost of more than $$25,000$ $100,000$ shall meet the requirements of this section.$
STATEMENT OF FACT
This bill reflects the inflationary cost for school construction by changing the amount for the

costs for school construction projects or minor capital costs from \$25,000 to \$100,000, provided that all state building specifications are met.
