B. Notwithstanding a provision of statute or charter to the contrary, school administrative units may adopt an annual budget prior to June 30th, except that the school budgets for vocational regions shall be adopted on or before August 1st September 30th.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Presently, the law requires a finalization of the school budget by June 30th. This bill allows municipalities which have changed the fiscal year to be able to complete their annual town audit, and publish the annual town report, prior to town meetings. Only one town meeting will be required to handle the school and municipal budgets.
