17 AN ACT to Allow Voter Registration and  
18 Party Enrollment on the Same Form.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 Sec. 1. 21 MRSA §102-A, sub-§4, as repealed and  
23 replaced by PL 1973, c. 131, §1, is repealed.

24 Sec. 2. 21 MRSA §102-A, sub-§5, as enacted by PL  
25 1973, c. 131, §2, is amended to read:

26 5. Enrollment. An individual may register and  
27 enroll in a political party at the same time and on  
28 the same form.

29 Sec. 3. 21 MRSA §131, first ¶ is amended to  
30 read:

1       As seen as When a person has registered regis-  
2 ters, the registrar shall ask him whether he wishes  
3 to enroll. If his answer is in the affirmative, the  
4 registrar shall provide him with an enrollment cause  
5 the person to complete the enrollment portion of the  
6 application.

8       The purpose of this bill is to permit voter  
9 registration and party enrollment on one form.

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
