17 AN ACT Concerning Eligibility to Hunt  
18 Moose.

20 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as  
21 follows:

22 12 MRSA §7463-A, sub-§5, as enacted by PL 1981,  
23 c. 118, §2, is amended to read:

24 5. Eligibility. Any Except as provided in this  
25 subsection, any Maine resident, nonresident or alien  
26 who is eligible to obtain a Maine hunting license is  
27 eligible to apply for a moose hunting permit. No  
28 person who has obtained a moose hunting permit may  
29 apply again for another permit until 3 years have  
30 elapsed since the issuance of the last permit. This  
31 limitation shall not apply to subpermittees.

## STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill requires any person who has obtained a moose hunting permit to wait 3 years before becoming eligible to apply for another permit. This limitation shall not apply to subpermittees.

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
