	§411. Informal briefings
	1. Nothing in this chapter may be constured to require informal briefing sessions conducted by a private enterprise for the purpose of confidential disclosure of the plans of that private enterprise be open to the public.
	2. These informal briefing sessions are not public proceedings as defined by section 402 of this subchapter.
