18 19 20 21 22 23 24 25 26	The Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages estimates that the bill, as amended, would result in increased net revenues to the General Fund of \$1,777,500 in fiscal year 1983-84, and \$2,370,000 in fiscal year 1984-85. The difference is because the bill is not an emergency measure. Anticipated bank charges of approximately \$140,000 annually are deducted prior to deposit and enactment should not result in any further administrative cost for the bureau.
