23	5 MRSA §1124, sub-§5 is enacted to read:

Notwithstanding section 1033, subsection 3, the provisions of this section in effect on June 30, 1982, with the exception of sub- section 4, are applicable to each participating local district which has adopted this section as part of its plan regardless of whether or not the district has adopted amendments enacted subsequent to its adoption of this section as part of its plan.

STATEMENT OF FACT The purpose of this bill is to allow a more stan-dard and uniform application of Title 5, section 1124, ordinary death benefits, to all members of the Maine State Retirement System.
