Gasoline powered motor vehicles used for the transportation of property or passengers for hire as a contract or common carrier, except farm trucks used primarily for transportation of agri- cultural commodities, supplies or equipment to be used in connection with the operation of a farm;

3	The purpose of this bill is to exempt farm trucks from the requirement of obtaining a fuel use iden- tification decal.
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
