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21 22	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
23	23 MRSA §1201, sub-§35 is enacted to read:
24	35. Bowdoin College. Signs shall be provided by
25	Bowdoin College and installed and maintained by the
26	Maine Turnpike Authority. The signs shall conform
27	with standards established by the Maine Turnpike
28	Authority and shall read and be located as follows.
29	A. At Exit 22 North in Brunswick a sign reading:
30	BOWDOIN COLLEGE THIS EXIT
31	B. At Exit 24 South in Topsham a sign reading:

5	STATEMENT OF FACT
6 7 8 9 10 11	The purpose of this bill is to provide for direc- tional signs on the Maine Turnpike indicating the location of Bowdoin College. The location of the sign in Bowdoinham is necessary because persons head- ing south on I-95 often mistake the Town of Bowdoin for Bowdoin College.
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
