STATE OF MAINE
IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED AND EIGHTY-THREE
AN ACT to Designate the Atlantic Salmon as a Game Fish.
Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
$12\ MRSA\ \S7615$, as enacted by PL 1979, c. 420, $\S1$, is amended to read:
§7615. Purchase or sale of certain fish
A person is guilty, except as provided in section 7630, subsection 2, of purchase or sale of black bass, landlocked salmon, <u>Atlantic salmon</u> , pickerel, togue, trout or white perch if he purchases or sells any of those fish either directly or indirectly.

1	STATEMENT OF FACT
2	The purpose of this bill is to designate the Atlantic salmon as a game fish.
