This bill removes ambiguous and unnecessary language from the charter of the transit district set up by the Legislature to take over ferry service from the bankrupt Casco Bay Lines. When the transit district was established, its purpose was to maintain reliable ferry service to the islanders. If the transit district expanded into the excursion service, it would destroy the small private excursion services and also overtax its own limited capacity.

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
