AN ACT to Provide Itemized Hospital
Bills to Medicare Beneficiaries and Medicaid Recipients.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

22 MRSA §1712 is enacted to read:
§1712. Itemized bills
The Department of Human Services may not make a payment to any general hospital in the State which is certified for participation under the United States Social Security Act, Title 18 or 19 , unless itemized bills are provided to all Title 18 beneficiaries and Title 19 recipients.

Currently Medicare beneficiaries and Medicaid recipients are not provided with itemized hospital bilis showing the costs and services incurred during their hospitalization. Without these detailed bills, beneficiaries are not fully aware of service costs. This bill provides for the itemized hospital bills to all Medicare beneficiaries and Medicaid recipients in the State.
